St. Bernard Parish Assessor Jaylynn Bergeron Turner has announced that, until further notice, the St. Bernard Parish Assessor's office will remain closed to physical visits from the Public, in order to maintain the safety of St. Bernard Parish residents.

For the time being, all services available to the public can be efficiently handled either through **Telephone – (504) 279-6379** or by **E-mail – [info@stbassessor.org](mailto:info@stbassessor.org) or [Dawn@stbassessor.org](mailto:Dawn@stbassessor.org)**

Examples of services that can be handled remotely are as follows:

- 1) Filing of any homestead exemption or 65 freeze or Disability freeze: You may telephone us for information on what you need to complete your homestead exemption application or your Freeze, and then you may e-mail us the proof needed, and we can e-mail you back the form to be signed and completed.
- 2) Looking up any property ownership or assessment question to satisfy a resident's inquiry: You may telephone us with the information you need, and we can inform you of the answer(s) and/or e-mail you the parcel listing of the property you are inquiring about.
- 3) Property Bond letter: If an assessment certification letter is needed to secure a property bond, you may telephone us with the property address to be used, and we can e-mail you and the Clerk's office the needed letter from our office to help complete the Clerk of Court's property bond process.

We look forward to assisting your needs, while keeping the health and safety of our residents in mind during this current health crisis.
